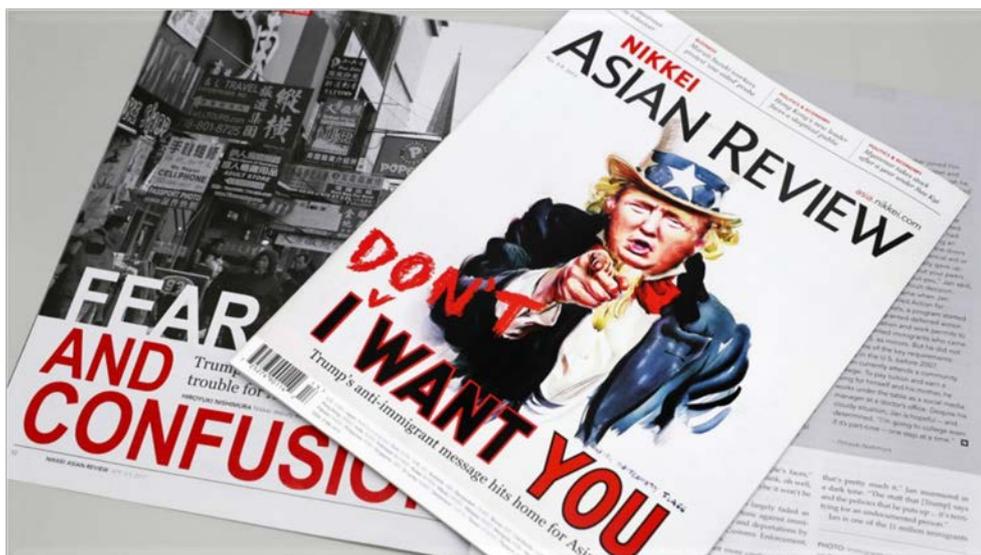


Nikkei Asian Review recognized at Asian Media Awards



April 26, 2018 - The Nikkei Asian Review was honored with a bronze prize in the Asian Media Awards 2018 presented by the World Association of Newspapers and News Publishers for its coverage of foreign students and immigrants living in the U.S. under President Donald Trump's hardline immigration policy. It is the first time the Nikkei Asian Review received this prestigious award which recognizes excellence in print journalism in the Asia-Pacific region and the Middle East.

The Nikkei Asian Review's April 3-9 2017 cover story package, ["I don't want you -- Trump's anti-immigrant message hits home for Asians,"](#) won the bronze prize in the category of Newspaper Feature Article.

The piece featured a lead story by news editor Hiroyuki Nishimura about foreign students and undocumented immigrants from Asia facing an uncertain future under the Trump administration's tough immigration policy. The piece also included dispatches from across Asia -- India, the Philippines, Malaysia, Indonesia, China and South Korea -- describing how the shift in immigration policy has upended the lives of people who rely on the U.S. for work, education and remittances.

WAN-IFRA is a global news organization, representing 18,000 publications in 120 countries and regions. The 17th Asian Media Awards covered seven areas, including editorial content, photojournalism, design and infographics, attracted a total of 435 entries from 58 media organizations.

The World Association of Newspapers and News Publishers, or WAN-IFRA, held the award ceremony on Wednesday during a Publish Asia 2018 event in Bali, Indonesia.
